

Rotary Hoe - Corn & Soybean Tips

- Soil must be constantly striated to reduce weeds from growing
- Use a rotary hoe prior to crop emergence, after crop emergence, and in standing crop
 - Targets white root hair stage of weeds
 - Is not very effective on weeds you can see
- Operates safely at a speed between 12-15mph
- Quantify crop damage when in standing crop
- Alternate direction on future passes
- Consider operating during high sun when crop is at a young and tender state of emergence
- Interlace the rotary hoe in between early cultivation passes
