

Weed Burning Tips

- Effective weed management tool especially during a wet season
- Each crop has a specific burn window(s)
- Speed, flame angle, pressure, and amount are all important
- Each type of Burner has specific settings
- Estimated fuel usage
 - Broadcast: 10 - 12 gallons
 - Banding: 4 - 5 gallons
- More effective on broadleaves (vs. grass)
 - Treat broadleaf weeds early (1-3"), lower propane requirements
 - Cultivate grasses shortly after
- Wait to burn until dew is off leaves
- Assess damage with fingerprint test
